Mailbox labor pricing *

Labor costs ARM will charge for mailbox repair/installation:

- -Mailbox install on existing wood base: \$60
- -Mailbox install on new wood base: \$75
- -Newspaper holder install: \$50
- -Mailbox post repair on existing base: \$100
- -New mailbox post install using all other existing components: \$175
- -Mailbox complete install using all new components including base: \$275
- -Painting: \$75
- -Mailbox placard (for numbers) install: \$40
- -Placard brass number install: \$40

Winter Street Reminders

Millcreek Rules state there is no parking on the street during winter snow removal. Vehicles may be towed. The Township will not be responsible for lawn damage if the following precautions are not taken:

- Lawn stakes must be installed by November 1st each year and are permitted through April 15th.
- Yard marker stakes need to be 4 feet tall and placed 1 foot away from the edge of the paved road.

Winter or all season tires?

When comparing winter tires to all-season tires, winter tires are designed to provide significantly better traction and handling in cold, snowy conditions due to their specialized rubber compound that stays flexible at low temperatures, while all-season tires are a compromise that can handle mild winter weather but are not as effective in extreme snow or ice situations; essentially, winter tires offer superior grip on icy roads while all-season tires are better for a wider range of temperatures throughout the year, but with less winter performance.
