A few words from the President

Hello Neighbors,

I hope everyone had an outstanding summer. It's always a bittersweet time of year as we admire the beautiful colors of the trees, knowing that summer has come to an end and we all know what comes next.

As your president, I have to address some issues that aren't always pleasant to talk about. The position of **enforcement officer** is not an easy one, and we're fortunate that **Eric Rogers** stepped up to fill this important role.

As every homeowner knows, Whispering Woods is a neighborhood with established **restrictions**. Unfortunately, it seems that some neighbors have either forgotten or chosen to ignore a few of them. I'm going to list a number of restrictions that continue to be violated. If any of these sound familiar, you may be one of the homeowners who is not following the rules you agreed to when moving into our community:

- Portable basketball hoops: Violation of Restriction #30;
- Mailboxes missing approved parts: Violation of Restriction #23;
- Signs in your yard (including contractor signs after work is completed): Violation of Restriction #24:
- Fences anywhere on your property: Violation of Restriction #26:
- Satellite dishes in your front yard: Violation of Restriction #28;
- Flags: As of the amended declaration dated May 25, 2011, one garden flag is allowed. If you have more than one, you are in violation of Restriction #24.

These are just a few of the recurring issues. Additionally, please remember that the speed limit throughout the neighborhood is 25 mph, not 45.

If you notice something wrong or broken in the neighborhood play area, please call one of the board members so the issue can be addressed and fixed promptly — before posting on the Whispering Woods Face-

I'm sorry to have to remind some neighbors about these restrictions, but for those of you who do follow the rules, we sincerely thank you. It makes the voluntary jobs of all board members so much easier.
